



PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

Airlie Gardens is happy to offer a unique backdrop for both amateur and professional photography. Our photograph fee provides ongoing fundraising to help maintain the beauty of the gardens and its services.

Portrait Photography | \$100/hour: Portrait photography includes, but is not limited to: bridal, family, engagement, maternity, quinceañera, graduation, prom; as well as, formal or event-specific attire, the use of props, an arranged photographer (amateur or professional), a change of clothing, or other situations determined by staff.

After-Hours Reservation | \$250/hour: After-hours portrait sessions are available on select evenings and must be scheduled in advance. Fee includes golf cart assistance and private access to all 67 acres of Airlie Gardens.

Commercial Shoot | \$300/hour: Commercial sessions must be scheduled in advance and during regular garden hours. Golf cart assistance may be added for an additional fee and must be prearranged.

- ❖ Fee does not include a photographer. You are responsible for coordinating with a photographer of your choosing.
- ❖ All Airlie rules apply, including no smoking. Rules are posted in our lobby and throughout the Gardens.
- ❖ Airlie Members must make a reservation (fee waived one time for Magnolia and Azalea Members).
- ❖ Pets are not allowed on the grounds, though service animals are permitted.
- ❖ A signed release is required for any images specific to Airlie Gardens that are placed on exhibit, sold for profit, or used for advertising. An additional fee may be charged for use of images.
- ❖ Do not climb trees, enter water areas, or step into plant beds.
- ❖ Do not put backpacks, equipment, or props on trees or in plant beds.
- ❖ A public restroom is available for changing. Do not change clothing in the garden.
- ❖ All photo subjects must be fully and appropriately clothed. Swimsuit, underwear and boudoir photo shoots are not permitted.
- ❖ Drones are not permitted to fly.
- ❖ Balloons, open flames (candles, lanterns, sparklers, etc.), smoke bombs and confetti are not allowed.
- ❖ Any props or decorations must be preapproved by Airlie Gardens before arrival.
- ❖ If your session is scheduled during normal garden hours, Airlie Gardens will remain open to the public and will not section off any part of the gardens. You must allow access when others wish to pass.
